October 10 through October 25, 2009
Itinerary***

- Day 1**—We begin our trip today as we travel to Charlotte, NC where we will spend the night. Dinner on your own tonight. Drury Inn.
- Day 2**—This morning we continue our trip north arriving in Charlottesville, VA this afternoon, where we will visit Monticello, home of Thomas Jefferson. Afterwards we go onto to Woodstock, VA. Comfort Inn (DCB)
- Day 3**—This morning we will head for Niagara Falls, Canada arriving late afternoon. Tonight we will be at the Hampton Inn North of the Falls. Dinner will be on your own. They provide a free shuttle downtown. (DCB)
- Day 4**—Today we will spend the morning and early afternoon in Niagara Falls and then head for Syracuse, NY where we will spend the night. Tonight we will have dinner out. Comfort Inn (2nts) (DCB,D)
- Day 5**—This morning we will head to Vermont with our first stop this afternoon at Shelburne Museum near Burlington. Afterwards we travel a short distance to Williston, VT to spend the next two nights. Fairfield Inn (DCB)
- Day 6**— Today we will head for the state capital for a walk and then a visit to the Morse Sugar Farm. Later we will visit the Cold Hollow Cider Mill and Ben & Jerry's Ice Cream. We will then return to Burlington for a cruise on Lake Champlain. Tonight we will return to our motel in Williston. (DCB)
- Day 7**—This morning we will head for Lincoln, New Hampshire and a visit to Franconia Notch State Park site of the "former" Old Man in the Mountain, where we visit the Flume, a natural gorge and waterfall. Later we will drive to Loon Mountain, where lunch will be included and then we will take a Gondola ride to the summit where you will be able to walk the trails and go up the observation tower. Dinner will be included tonight. Comfort Inn Lincoln (2 nights) (DCB,D)
- Day 8**—This morning we will head for Concord, NH to participate in the Concord Capital City YRE. Later we will travel to Meredith, NH where we will have lunch at Hart's Turkey Farm and then after lunch take a scenic ride on the Lake Winnepesaukee Railroad. We will return to our motel this afternoon. (DCB)
- Day 9**—Today we will travel one of the most scenic highways in the United States, the Kancamagus Highway through the White Mountains with photo ops along the way. We will arrive in Augusta, ME around noon time where you will have time for lunch on your own and then we will participate in the Augusta Capital City YRE, afterwards we will travel to York, ME for the evening. Tonight we will have a lobster dinner at Warrens Lobster House. (2nts) (DCB,D)
- Day 10**— Today we will take a short drive to Kennebunkport, ME for a guided tour and then go back to Portsmouth for a tour of Historic Portsmouth including a visit to the John Paul Jones House and the Cape Neddick Lighthouse. We will then do the Portsmouth YRE. (DCB)
- Day 11**— Today is a riding—walking— riding—walking—riding day with lots to see and do. We will leave Portsmouth and drive to Boston where we will do the Freedom Trail YRE. After lunch on your own we will travel to Providence, RI where we will do the Capital City YRE and then go on to Hartford, CT to spend the night. (DCB,D)
- Day 12**—This morning we will enjoy the Hartford Capital City YRE and travel to West Point, NY where we will do the YRE at West Point Academy. Later we will travel to Bethlehem, PA to spend the night. Dinner included tonight. Comfort Inn (DCB,D)
- Day 13**— Today we will drive to Lancaster, PA for a tour of Amish Country, followed by a family style lunch. Afterwards we will we travel to Hershey, PA for a stop at Hershey Chocolate World. We will spend the night in Hershey. Comfort Inn (DCB)
- Day 14**— This morning we will travel to Gettysburg National Military Park where we will have a tour of the park, afterwards you will have time for lunch on your own in historic Gettysburg. We will then travel to Staunton, VA to spend the night. Comfort Inn. (DCB)
